A Pastoral Letter

Dear friends in Christ,

Teddy and Chip – Chip and Teddy.

They go together like meatballs and spaghetti.

Please excuse the clumsy poem, but I would like to share a story with you. A story of Chip and Teddy. Two of God's children that will never meet each other – at least not in this life. Two of God's children that will always be linked in my heart.

You see Teddy was born just three days before Chip died. Teddy came into this world in the same hospital where Chip was approaching the end of his time with us. One sun was rising, as the other was setting. I visited Teddy one day after he was born. I celebrated his new life with his parents. We prayed for God's blessings, planned his coming baptism. and shared Holy Communion.

That same day, I visited Chip, who I had never met before. My visit with Chip was different than my visit with Teddy, but not as different as you would think. We prayed for God's blessings, remembered his baptism and shared Holy Communion with his close-knit family of over 20 people in the hospital room. Being a Pastor, I often get to participate with families in the joy of new life – full of hope and promise. I also get to grieve with families who lose loved ones, share in their mourning and in their tears – but still a time full of joy and promise. I don't often get to experience these two events connected in such a powerful way.

Birth is joyful and uplifting. Death is crushing and defeating. At least that is the common wisdom. But we know different don't we.

As Christians, we know that life and death are linked together through our baptisms. In my simultaneous witness to the birth of Teddy and the death of Chip, I saw this truth as I never had before. Teddy's birth was filled with hope and promise. Chip's death was filled with hope and promise. The same hope and promise for both. Because Chip had been baptized into Christ's death, and also into his resurrection. For Chip death was not the end, but the beginning of life.

By the time you read this message, Teddy will have been baptized at Emmanuel on July 28, 2019. The hope and promise Teddy has at the beginning of life is no different than the one Chip has carried into eternal life.

That is the very same hope and promise we all carry through life – from our baptisms to our funerals, and at every event in between. Through our baptisms we are linked forever to the resurrection of Jesus Christ who has power over all things – even the darkest of all things – our deaths. St. Paul writes to the Romans – “whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord”. Thanks be to God for the life of Chip. Thanks be to God for the new life of Teddy. Joined in life and death, hope and promise, resurrection and eternity. Children of a gracious God.

Chip and Teddy - Teddy and Chip

They go together – through baptism's dip.

Sorry again for the clumsy poem. But I think you get the picture. Praying that you always live your life in hope and in promise.

We give thanks to God for having this resource and for those who took the time to contribute to it over many years.

During its time, so many innovative ways of communicating information have emerged, and they all offer us opportunities to increase and improve the sharing of information important to members and friends of Emmanuel. Accordingly, I am announcing that this issue of the Bell Tower will be its last.

Just because we are saying goodbye to the Bell Tower does not mean we will be saying goodbye to communications of all the great things happening at Emmanuel.

Just the opposite is true.

Starting October 1, here are the new ways you can expect to hear about all that's going on at Emmanuel.

1. An expanded bulletin format will serve as a weekly newsletter. You will be able to get the bulletin in three ways. Of course, the best way will be to pick one up at weekly worship. But, if you are not able to do that, we post the weekly bulletin to our website www.emmanuelchurch.net. You can also request the office to have the bulletin mailed to you, each week.

3. Increased use of Social Media to announce special events, invite community conversation, post blogs and vlogs, and broadcast live events – including (in the coming months) our worship services.

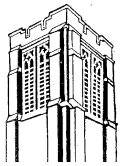

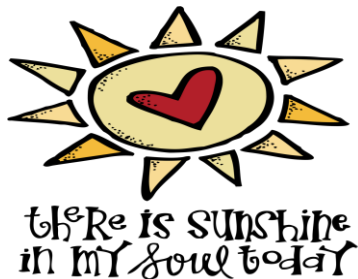

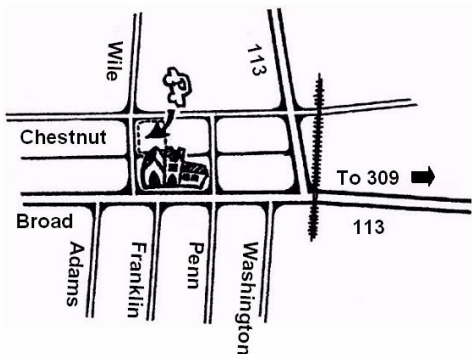
